


## **Beat the Heat**

Drink water often (about 4 cups/hour)



Allow yourself time to acclimatize



Schedule most strenuous work to cooler times of day Attend training about the hazards leading to heat stress and how to prevent them.



Stop work immediately if you or a coworker exhibit signs of heatrelated illness Establish workrest schedules to include a 10 -20 20 minute cooloff period every hour

Limit physical exertion when possible (e.g., use mechanical lifts) Wear a hat and light weight, light colored, loose fitting clothes.

- Process
  - Agree to basic terms and conditions in advance
  - Insert specific scope of work language for each project
- Criteria
  - Past performance
  - Safety record
  - Financial strength
- Benefits
  - Execute completed subcontract quickly and efficiently
  - Avoid prolonged negotiation over terms and condition



## **Flexible Bonding Approach**

- No Set Contract Amount
- Discretion to Waive Bonding Requirements
  - Nature of work
  - Financial status
- Prefer Prequalification Process (Trade Tapp)
- Typical Bonded Subs
  - Scope over \$250K
  - MEP
  - Building envelope

- If Bonds Are Required
  - Must be issued by a surety licensed in Texas
  - Must be issued on Vaughn's bond forms
  - Subcontractor is responsible for premium increases and/or decreases due to changes in work
  - Subcontractor is responsible for including any additional costs in applicable change orders
