

## What is State Surplus?

The Texas Facilities Commission is statutorily charged with the state's surplus property program.

When a Texas state agency has surplus property, the property is posted on the Internet for 10 business days. During that 10-day period, only qualified entities may obtain the property from state agencies. **After the 10-day period, the public is eligible to purchase the property!**

- **Vehicles such as vans, trucks, passenger vehicles and retired trooper vehicles**



- **Abandoned airport property such as multi-purpose tools, knives, toys, money clips, lighters, sunglasses, reading glasses, snow globes, and jewelry**



- **Miscellaneous DPS equipment**



- **Watercraft, boat engines**

- **Office furniture such as chairs, desks, filing cabinets, filing organizers and screens**

- **Office supplies**
