As the State of Texas Capitol Complex Project progresses, there will be changes to vehicular and pedestrian travel patterns. This newsletter will provide updates and maps of the new pedestrian and traffic routes.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Sidewalk Closures

- December 17 - Sidewalk between Bullock Museum and SF Austin will be closed.
- Thru December 17 - Congress Ave sidewalk of RE Johnson Building will be closed.

PARKING UPDATE

- There is no street parking on N. Congress Avenue. (Effective 12-01-2018).
- Garages E and J are full. Use Garage A or B instead.

NEW PEDESTRIAN ROUTES AND FENCING

Effective 12-17-2018

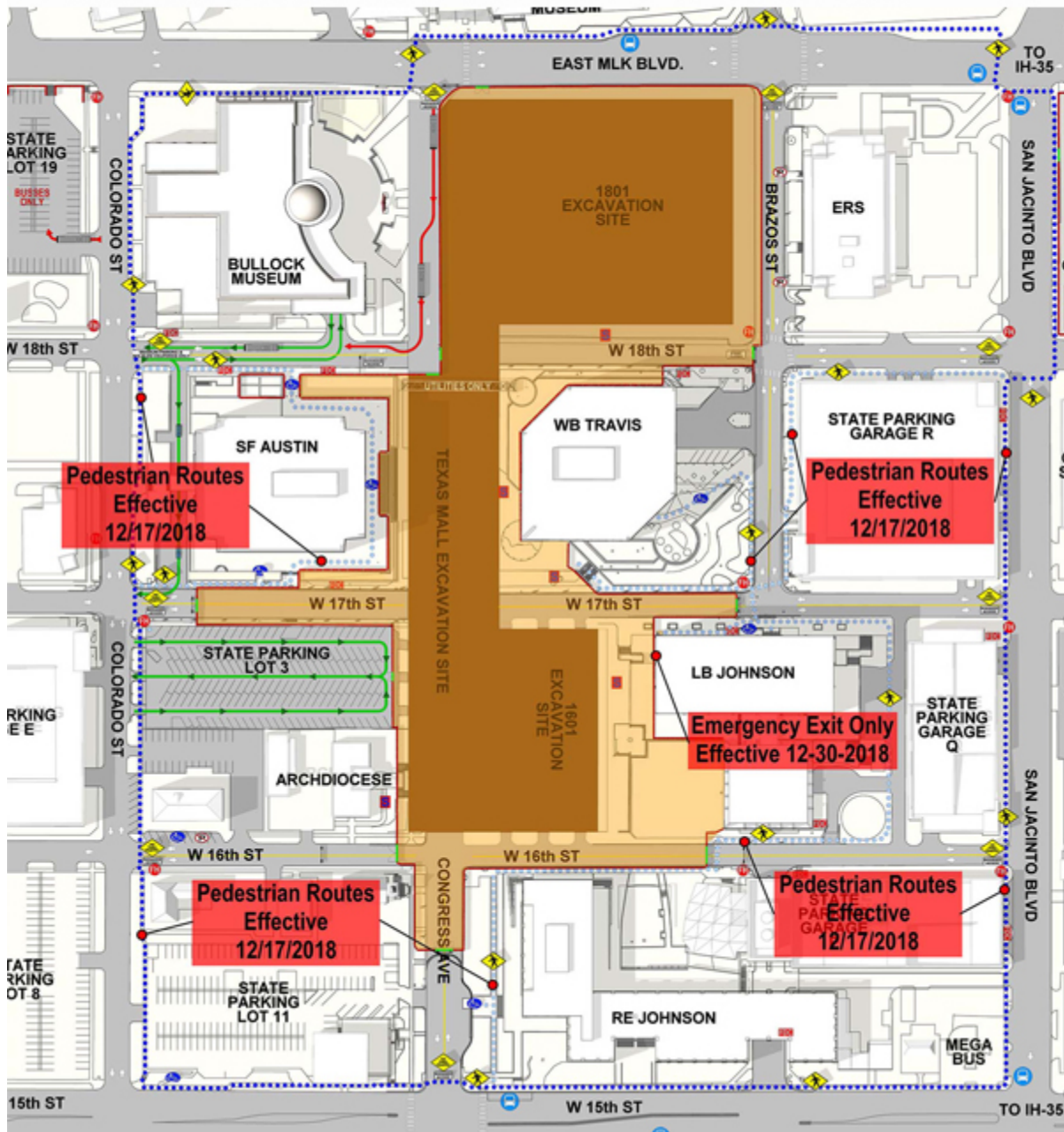
NOTE: Pedestrians may need to walk around some buildings.

Look for these changes on the map below.

- **S.F. Austin Building (SFA)** - W. 18th at Colorado and along W. 17th. ([view building map](#))
- **R.E. Johnson Building (REJ)** - Congress Ave entrance and the San Jacinto entrance of the parking garage. Construction of the drop off and turn-around lane at 15th and N. Congress (at the REJ Building) continues. ([view building map](#))
- **L.B. Johnson Building (LBJ)** - 16th Street Crosswalk. ([view building map](#))
- **W.B. Travis Building (WBT)** - Crosswalk at Brazos & 17th. ([view building map](#))
- **State Parking Garage R** - Brazos sidewalk and San Jacinto sidewalk.
- **State Parking Lot 11** - Colorado sidewalk and Congress Ave. sidewalk.

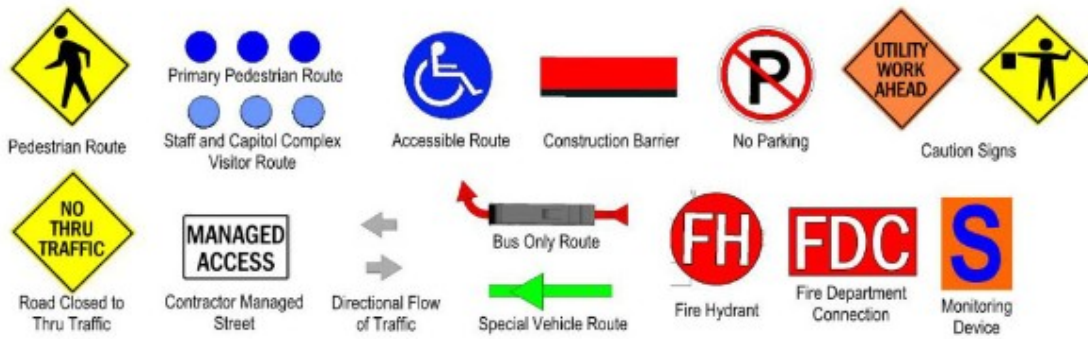
GENERAL NEWS

- North Congress Ave. is now closed between MLK Blvd. and 15th street.
- Parking Lot 2 is also closed. Agency Reserved spaces have been relocated to nearby garages.
- Southbound bus and Museum traffic from MLK will remain open, as well as the DPS Parking.

The fence around the MLK Blvd. construction area will be updated.

- Parking Lot 3 is scheduled to remain open until early 2019. The lot has been restriped for traffic to enter and exit via Colorado St.
